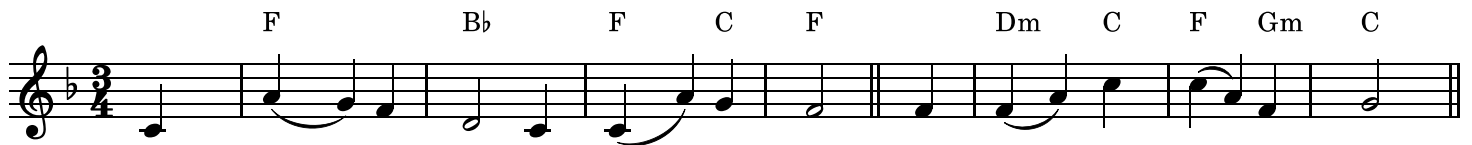


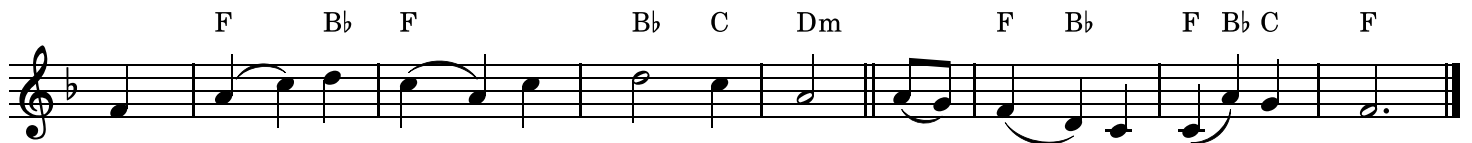

Verses 1-3

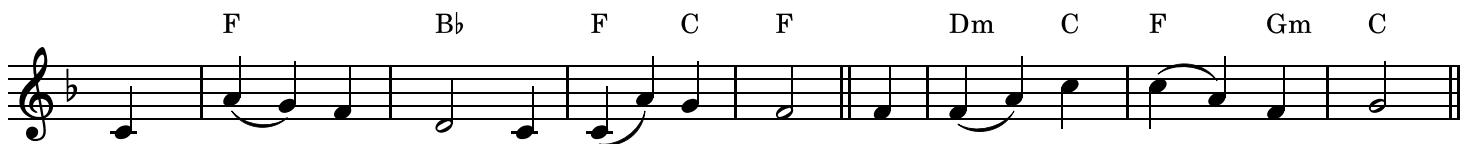


1. The Lord's_ my sav - iour and_ my light who will_ make me_ dis - mayed?

3. Al - though an arm - y hems_ me in, my heart will feel no dread;

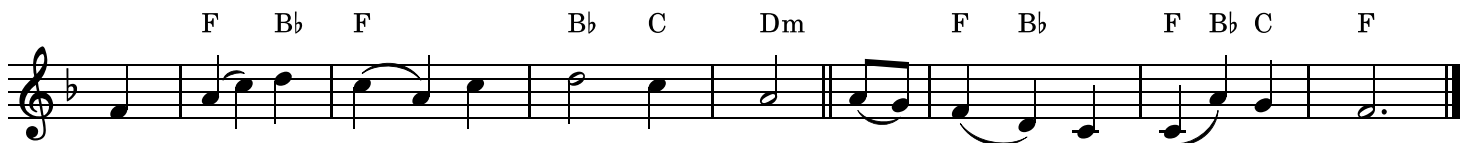


The Lord's the strong - hold of my life why should I be_ a - fraid?
